## APPLICATION RATES FOR ORGANIC FERTILIZER

### **ESTABLISHED LAWNS:**

Broadcast 25 lbs. of fertilizer per 1000 square feet evenly over lawn. May be necessary to repeat application mid-summer and fall. Water thoroughly.

### **NEW LAWNS**

Broadcast 40-50 lbs. per 1000 square feet and work the fertilizer into the top soil. Seed, sprig, or sod. Water thoroughly until grass is established.

### SHRUBS AND HEDGES

Use 3-5 lbs. per 100 square feet in spring after last killing frost. Be sure fertilizer is mixed with mulch. Water thoroughly.

# FRUIT, NUT, AND SHADE TREES:

Apply 1-3 lbs. per inch of trunk diameter. Apply 2 cups of fertilizer per hole not to exceed 8" deep, at 3' intervals evenly around the tree, starting at the edge of the branches.

### **HOUSE PLANTS**

### **FLOWER BEDS**

1 TSP.	4" POT	Apply 5 lbs. per 100 sq. feet and work
1 TBLS.	6" POT	into soil. Can be reapplied every 6
2 TSP.	8" POT	weeks at the rate of 3 lbs. per 100 sq.
3 TBLS.	12" POT	feet. Water thoroughly.

### **VEGETABLES**

Broadcast 3-5 lbs. per 100 square feet. For row crops, broadcast 2 - 3 lbs. per 100 square feet, preferably 1 - 2 inches to the side of the seed.
